## **Using Zoom**

We use Zoom to host our classes and we want to make sure you'll be able to join us. If you want to check your ability to join a zoom meeting, this link: <https://zoom.us/test> will take you to a test meeting.

## **The Day of Class**

- 1) When you are ready to join the class, click on the Zoom class link and it will ask you to enter in the meeting ID and password. Enter in this information and Zoom will tell you to wait in a waiting room until the class moderator lets you into the class.
- 2) Once you are let into the class, Zoom will ask you if you want to join with audio and video. You can opt out of both of these if you want. If you do join in with audio, we ask that you keep your mic muted when you aren't speaking. This helps to reduce any extra background noise that may be distracting to the instructor and other students.
- 3) The moderator will let people into the room 10-15 minutes before the class is scheduled to start.
- 4) We will email students a recording of the class within a day or two after the class ends. When you receive the recording, simply click on the link and enter in the password. Recordings can be viewed for 2 weeks, so please plan accordingly so that you have enough time to watch it before access to it expires.
